We are a young family in Selfoss, south Iceland (originally from Switzerland and Germany) who had the idea in 2015 to create an absolutely unique and romantic getaway together in Iceland where it is possible to watch the northern lights and the midnight sun right out of the comfort of your bed or private hot tub.

That's why we designed the Panorama Glass Lodges. Our houses were the first in Iceland (2017) where it is possible to sleep under a glass ceiling. Panorama Glass Lodge is still the most famous and most popular Glass Accommodation you can book in Iceland, with absolutely the best views!

Even though the 7 cabins are out in the nature (South and West Iceland), including one premium glass lodge in West Iceland, our guests can still enjoy luxury, high quality standards and extraordinary design.

The shape of the Lodges is inspired by Icelandic houses and the combination of wooden elements with steel and glass makes the Lodges unique. The interior is completely custom made and sustainable whereby high value was placed on the details. We respect nature and use only materials that do no harm to our beautiful surroundings. The water is the purest in the world, coming directly from a nearby spring. We use sustainable electricity to heat up our pools.

We also use refillable cosmetics from the local brand Sóley Organics which are completely organic.

The Glass Lodges are located near Hella (south Iceland), a 1h40min min drive away from Reykjavík (1h50min from Keflavík airport), and Borgarnes, a 1h10min drive from Reykjavík (1h35min from Keflavík airport). Guests sleep in a glass house igloo with an amazing panorama view, where they will have the best chances to see the northern lights, that will be very bright & visible due to the remote location with almost no light pollution. It is also wonderful to enjoy the amazing midnight sun and golden hours during summertime.

The Lodges provide full privacy and are perfect for honeymoon or just an adventure trip, and we also have a premium lodge for up to 5 guests in the West, near Borgarnes. The custom-made king-size bed is standing in the middle of the glass house where guests sleep under the stars or midnight sun. Side curtains are available, if needed.

There can be surrounding light from the moon or sun and it's not getting completely dark. We provide sleeping masks during summer months.

We also provide a fully equipped kitchen with complimentary coffee & tea and basic food (like Pasta, Rice, Cereals, Vinegar & Oil) and a dining table with two chairs. A toaster, a fridge, two stoves, a microwave and a water heater are also available. We do not provide fresh food like animal products, vegs and also no breakfast.

The bathroom contains a big rainshower in a cozy spa ambience. There is also a private outdoor hotpot next to each Lodge with an amazing view over the volcano Hekla, the Icelandic highlands and a beautiful natural river. On the terrace our guests find a Weber BBQ grill and a hammock to relax at the fresh air if the weather allows it.

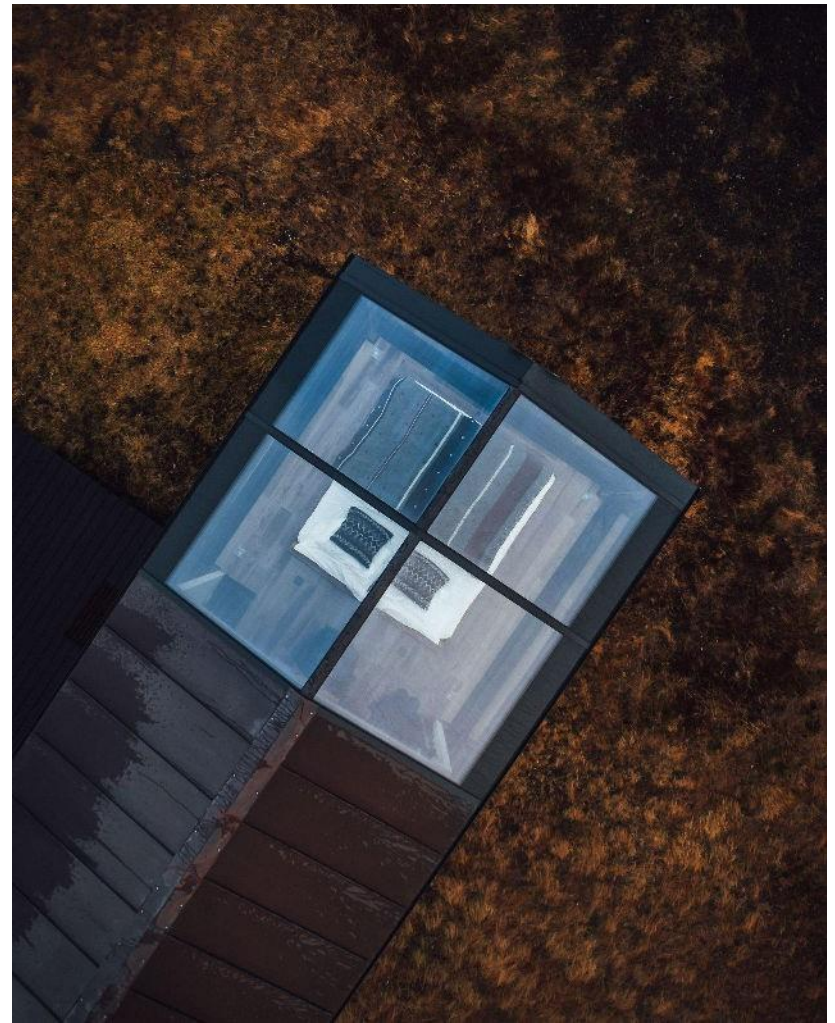

At the time of the settlement of Iceland around 900 AD, approximately 25-30% of Iceland was covered with trees and 30-35% with other plants. Today 75% of the country is completely deserted. Only about 1% of our land is still covered with forests. Since the settlement, 3.8 million hectares of grown land have been lost.
